This is done through collaboration with volunteers and staff through faithful planning and implementation of programs for spiritual growth and active attendance.

Responsibilities:

The responsibilities of the Director of Youth and Family Ministries shall include but are not limited to:

A. General and Administrative

- 1. Develop and implement Christian education growth objectives in conjunction with the pastor and VLC Christian Education Task Force to support the Clarity Plan (strategic plan) of the church.
- 2. Recruit and train church member volunteers with the task of shared teaching and leading Christian education.
- 3. Prepare budget and monitor expenses for all Christian education programs and activities.
- 4. Create and implement annual calendar of activities with VLC and Chapel School ministry team.

B. Children's Ministry

- 1. Identify and invite church members to volunteer in the Sunday school program and infant/toddler care room on Sunday mornings.
- 2. Coordinate Sunday School staff orientation, training, support and recognition.
- 3. Coordinate volunteers for current annual children's activities (such as VBS, Trunk or

Treat, Easter Egg Hunt, Sunday School Christmas Pageant) and expand children's opportunities and engagement.

4. Lead and/or coordinate Sunday morning Children's messages

C. Youth Ministry

- 1. Coordinate and implement spiritual, service, and social growth programs for our 3rd-12th grade youth.
- 2. Conduct weekly bible study groups for 3rd-6th grade youth (Voyagers) and 9th-12th graders (Crusaders)
- 3. Coordinate and teach within the Confirmation program with the Senior Pastor for the 7th-8th grade youth (Lifers) and the First Communion preparation classes (5th + grades)
- 4. Facilitate Youth involvement in worship services and other opportunities for music and drama
- 5. Create and implement social activities throughout the year
- 6. Create outreach and service opportunities for youth and their families.
- 7. Facilitate regular communication with parents, volunteers and youth.
- 8. Maintain connection and encourage congregation wide support of post-high school youth particularly during the college years.

D. Family Ministry

- 1. Plan and implement innovative programs and special presentations to support and encourage the spiritual growth and development of the whole family.
- 2. Design creative programs toward community outreach and engagement.
- 3. Work with The Chapel School administration and faculty and staff to plan and support cooperative learning and service opportunities.
