### A. Mission Support Report (March 31, 2018) (EXHIBIT C)

Sue Brandt provided the following report to the Council:

Contributions for the month of February were \$61,145.05, which is \$3,853.95 less than what was budgeted (65,000). Contributions for the month of March were \$84,416.80, which is \$10,583.20 less than what was budgeted (95,000). Year-to-date mission support received is \$145,562.85, which is \$14,437.15 lower than the budgeted amount of \$160,000.00.

## A. Process for the Election of the Bishop (EXHIBIT E)

In consultation with ELCA Secretary Chris Boerger, it was determined that the process for the election of the Bishop adopted by the Synod Assembly in 2012 and implemented in 2014 does not apply to subsequent Bishop elections. The process for 2019 will include the pre-identification of possible pastors who exhibit the gifts and skills necessary to serve as bishop.
