She also met with several pastors of our synod: Pr. David Anglada on May 6, Pr. Lenny Duncan on May 8, Pr. Amy Kienzle on May 22, and Pr. Ernie Mossl on May 26. She attended a Mets game on June 7 with Pr. Bob Kasting, Pr. Marc Herbst and Pr. Eric Olson

On May 28, VP Wicklund hosted VP Gail Kiyomura of the Sierra-Pacific Synod.

VP Wicklund, along with Tom Sargent, Pr. Gerry Squire and Pr. Chryll Crews, met with pastors of the Western Queens conference to present response to their October 2018 letter concerning redevelopment.

7. Treasurer's Report

A. Mission Support Report (31 May 2019)

Treasurer Litke reported that Mission Support received in May totaled \$69,708.19, which is \$4,545 less than budgeted for May. Mission Support received year-to-date is \$284,323.52, which is \$5,277 less than budgeted yearto-date. Good news is that annual Mission Support Commitments are up \$54,000 from 2018 and \$238,981 from 2017.

8. Old Business

A. Western Queens

VP Wicklund reported that she met with the Western Queens conference on June 5 to present the response to the Western Queens Inquiry. SC members in attendance with her were Tom Sargent, Pr. Chryll Crews and Pr. Garry Squire.

She presented the following resolution:

Whereas members of the Western Queens Conference have expressed a desire to continue exploration of establishing a new ministry site or sites on their territory; and

Whereas the congregations of Christ Evangelical Lutheran, Evangelical Lutheran Church of St. Philip, and St. Luke's Evangelical Lutheran Church completed their ministry in the hope and desire that a new ministry site or sites could be established,

Therefore, be it resolved

That the Metropolitan New York Synod shall provide a financial record-keeping mechanism to record the net value of the assets released to the Synod by the three Western Queens congregations that completed their ministry; and

That this record-keeping mechanism shall record also the financial costs to the Synod of exploring and/or establishing and nurturing a new ministry site or sites in the territory of Western Queens; and

That the net value in the record keeping mechanism shall provide guidance for the financial resources available for exploration and/or establishment and nurturance of a new ministry site or sites in the territory of Western Queens; and

That the continuation of the record-keeping mechanism shall be considered again by the synod council no more than five years after establishment of the mechanism.

ACTION SC19:06/08 RESOLVED:

That the Metropolitan New York Synod shall provide a financial record-keeping mechanism to record the net value of the assets released to the Synod by the three Western Queens congregations that completed their ministry; and

That this record-keeping mechanism shall record also the financial costs to the Synod of exploring and/or establishing and nurturing a new ministry site or sites in the territory of Western Queens; and

That the net value in the record keeping mechanism shall provide guidance for the financial resources available for exploration and/or establishment and nurturance of a new ministry site or sites in the territory of Western Queens; and

That the continuation of the record-keeping mechanism shall be considered again by the synod council no more than five years after establishment of the mechanism.
