A. Conference Visit / Schedule

Bishop reported that the priority of pastoral presence is being implemented with scheduled visits to each Conference of our synod beginning this month and ending in November 2020.

Treasurer Litke reported that Mission Support received in September totaled \$72,002.28, which is \$8,643.10 less than budgeted.

Mission Support received year-to-date is \$582,137.42 which is \$4,876.24 less than budgeted year-to-date.

7. Old Business

A. New Hope for All Saints property (163rd Street, Bronx)

VP Wicklund reported that we have not yet received a signed contract from the developer whose offer the SC approved in July. Should the approved offer be withdrawn, the SC will be presented with additional offers to consider in November.

B. Park Church Co-op

Bp. Egensteiner, S. Brandt, and B. Dupree met with leaders from Park Church on 10/9/19. They have agreed to the criteria to operate as a permanent synodical worshiping community.

- A permanent SAWC is semi-autonomous. They would continue to be a group gathered to worship in accordance with the expectations of the Synod.
- There would work in partnership with the Bishop's office to secure a part time pastor. The SC will extend the call to the pastor and provide real viability benchmarks to be met.
- Park Church Co-Op would be responsible for all their funding Rostered leader's salary, benefits, insurance etc.
- Considering the Messiah property belongs to the Synod, negotiate the rental agreement for facility use with the Synod.
- Although mostly autonomous, Park Church Co-Op would remain a SAWC which Synod Council has 51% authority over.
- Park Church would remain under the purview of the DEM. Only after an annual review will the DEM recommend they continue for another year.

Pr. David Parsons led SC in prayer prior to vote.

ACTION SC10:10/05

RESOLVED, that the Metropolitan New York Synod recognize Park Church Co-op, Brooklyn as a permanent Synodically Authorized Worshipping Community (SAWC) under the oversight of the MNYS Director for Evangelical Mission.

ADOPTED

(16 for, 4 against, 2 abstentions)

C. Eltingville Update

VP Wicklund said that our attorneys have reported that the self-appointed leaders of Eltingville have appealed the decision of the Appellate Division to the New York Court of Appeals (New York's highest court).

D. Amendment to contract for former Zion, Brooklyn

VP Wicklund reported that the Developer (Fifth Avenue Committee) and the School Construction Authority are negotiating final terms that will amend the contract. The contract is scheduled to close this month. It was hoped we would have the amendment for today's SC meeting.

She requested that the Synod Council authorize the Executive Committee to approve the amendment to the contract in the coming weeks and subsequently bring to the Synod Council to ratify in November.
