VP Del Toro briefly reviewed the manual and asked members to read it to become better acquainted with synod council procedure.

B. Synod Vice Presidents visit to Churchwide

VP Del Toro reported on her meeting for synod vice presidents at Churchwide.

C. Committee nomination form

VP Del Toro reviewed the nomination form that may be posted on the website and/or sent electronically to select groups of synod leaders when a committee initiates a search for members. Bp. Rimbo noted that all nominations should reflect the diversity of our synod.

4. Strategic Plan / Steering Committee

A. Capital Improvement Grant recipients

VP Del Toro reported that when the Capital Improvement Grant initiative was introduced at the Synod Assembly, the common understanding by the Assembly was an allocation of \$200K a year for five years. The 2014 budget allocated \$50K, followed by \$200K annually in the subsequent years. The 2014 grant application requests totaled somewhere between \$800K - \$900K. It was determined by the EC that the distribution schedule be modified to allocate \$200K for distribution in 2014.

ACTION SC 14:10/01

RESOLVED, that the Capital Grants to Congregations budget line for 2014 be increased from \$50,000 to \$200,000.

Dcn. John Prosen, a member of the Congregation Capital Improvement Grant Review Team, spoke briefly about the work of the committee. Bp. Rimbo asked Mr. Walter Nash and Ms. Wendy Bean Tannenbaum to share their thoughts as members of the Grant Review Team.
