Frank Suttell reported that for the month of October, we received \$88,758 vs. a budgeted amount of \$116,255, putting us under budget for the month by \$27,497. However, we were about \$26,000 ahead of budget at the end of September, so as of October 31<sup>st</sup>, we are behind by (\$1,546). Total MS received YTD is \$777,267 vs. a budgeted amount of \$778,813.
