The process of consolidation is moving along according to plans. Please check the bulletin boards in the Narthex and in the hallway to the Community Room.

Your Leadership Teams are working on finalizing a ULC constitution and bylaws, a mission statement, and business plan. Once completed, each congregation will vote on accepting them at their annual meetings. We are also working with our attorney on a petition to the Suffolk County Court to approve our consolidation.

As you can see, we have been very busy preparing to make ULC official.

A worship space survey to reflect on our time worshipping at St. Peter's has been distributed via email and is available in the Narthex. Please provide your feedback.

On May 4th following worship, we will have an open forum where we will update you on our progress, share some of the documents we have been working on, discuss options for our permanent worship home and take time to address any questions you may have. It is important for our progress that everyone has an opportunity to voice their concerns and ideas
